Round table/briefing "Theosophy and Society" in 7 areas: Cultural Studies/Art, History/Oriental Studies and Astrology/Kalachakra, Education/Pedagogy, Psychology, Philosophy, Physics/Natural Sciences

Seven branches of the Round Table "Theosophy and Society"

1. Cultural Studies/Art (orange) - speaker Lyubov Kazarnovskaya, Professor, member of the Russian Academy of Natural Sciences, Department's Artistic Director at the Institute of Contemporary Art, Artistic Director of the Department of Academic Voice, G.P. Vishnevskaya College of Musical and Theatrical Arts, social activist (Moscow, Russia).

He studied theology and religious studies at Yerevan State University, philosophy at Lomonosov Moscow State University, Sanskrit and Indian philosophy at the Institute of Oriental Studies of the Russian Academy of Sciences (Moscow, Russia).

Education/pedagogy (blue) - speaker Ilya Volnov, PhD in Technical Sciences, Associate Professor, Director of the Center for Technological Support of Education of Moscow Polytechnic University (Moscow, Russia). Participants: Vladimir Chernov, Doctor of Science in Economics, PhD, Professor of the Department of Finance and Credit of Nizhny Novgorod National Research State University named after N.I. Lobachevsky" (Nizhny Novgorod, Russia), Mikhail Chiriatchev, Corresponding Member of the International Academy of Sciences of Ecology, Man and Nature Protection, Advisor to the Russian Academy of Natural Sciences, Trustee of the International Roerich Memorial Trust in Kullu, India (St. Petersburg, Russia), delegates of the Congress.

6. Psychology (blue) - speaker Victoria Kravchenko, twice Doctor of Science in Philosophy, Professor of the International Law Institute (Moscow, Russia). 7. Physics/Natural Sciences (green) - speaker Sergey Roshchupkin, Doctor of Science in Physics and Mathematics, PhD, Professor of the Higher School of Fundamental Physical Research of Peter the Great St. Petersburg Polytechnic University (Russia, St. Petersburg). Participants: Michelina Foster, Doctor of Metaphysical Science, member of the Theosophical Society (California, USA), Egor Turley, PhD in Physics and Mathematics (Russia, Moscow), delegates of the Congress.

Briefing - 7 speakers, 7 round tables, 7 participants at each table. Each table is defined by color, each speaker has 7 cards with questions from participants online, each of the 7 participants of a round table can ask their question to the speaker.

II. Putting in turn each table with a speaker's team on each of the seven branches/ topics to live broadcasting with simultaneous translation into English and Russian. Live briefing work: presentation of the speaker, questions & answers, teamwork, discussion, opinions.

15 minutes for each team.

Awarding the winner of the contest "The best question to a speaker".

II. Live broadcast for all in a cross-questions & answers session.

The goal is the interaction of the branches, science areas in the general context of the Round Table "Theosophy and Society", cooperation, development and prospects of each branch in synthesis.

Transferring from one table to another questions which speakers and their teams may not have been able to answer, or a question turns out to be on a complementary topic, or a team wants a detailed answer with knowledge of another branch from the available 7 ones. This way there will be interaction of all 7 branches, 7 speakers, 7 teams.

Time limit is 10 minutes.

Summing up the results of the briefing by the speakers of each round table: the formation of ideas through interaction, long-term plans for the development of society, the foundations of the science of the future. The results of the discussion, the relevance of and demand for theosophical knowledge in society, in all spheres of society.

A final resolution of the Congress: interaction of the branches, cooperation, development and prospects of each branch: Cultural Studies, Philosophy, History / Oriental Studies, Psychology, Education / Pedagogy, Astrology, Natural Sciences based on a systemic study of theosophical works.

The time limit is 7 minutes for each of the 7 speakers of the 7 branches
