

REGULATIONS FOR CREATIVE CONTESTS

“THE JOURNEY OF THE WHITE JAGUARS”

I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.1. These Regulations define the status, objectives, tasks, and procedures for conducting the Creative Contests of the “White Jaguars” project.

1.2. The project is implemented with the support and participation of the Theosophy Foundation.

1.3. The organizer of the Contests is the Theosophy Foundation, “White Jaguars” project.

1.4. Partners of the Contests:

- International and Russian cultural organizations;
- Children's creative groups and educational centers.

II. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE CONTESTS

2.1. Goals of the Contests:

- To identify and nurture children’s unique creative abilities.
- To inspire children to create works that reflect their inner world, culture, nature, and spiritual values.
- To demonstrate the significance of children’s creativity as part of global culture and art.

2.2. Objectives of the Competitions:

- To develop children’s creative potential through artistic, musical, and literary self-expression.
- To promote children’s creativity as an important element of society’s spiritual and cultural development.
- To support young talents and create conditions for their further creative growth.
- To build a collection of unique children’s works that reflect the diversity of cultural and artistic traditions.

III. ORGANIZATION OF THE CONTESTS

3.1. The organization and conduct of the Contests are entrusted to the Organizing Committee (hereinafter referred to as the Organizing Committee), which consists of:

- Representatives of the Theosophy Foundation,
- Experts in the field of children’s creativity and art,
- Project partners.

3.2. The Contests are held online.

3.3. Application period: until **May 31, 2026**.

3.4. Information about the Contests is disseminated through:

- Children’s educational institutions,
- Creative associations and development centers,
- The project’s official online resources.

3.5. The Organizing Committee will tally the results and determine the winners.

3.6. Based on the results of the contests, the following is planned:

- Publication of an album or anthology featuring the best works,
- Awarding participants with certificates and diplomas.

IV. RULES FOR PARTICIPATION IN CONTESTS

4.1 Children from all regions of Russia and other countries are eligible to participate.

4.2 Age of participants: up to **8 years old**.

4.3 No more than **4 entries** will be accepted from a single participant.

4.4 The Organizing Committee reserves the right to use the submitted works (photos, videos) in informational and promotional materials for the project with the consent of the child’s parents or legal guardians.

V. PROCEDURES FOR SUBMITTING ENTRIES

5.1. Entry Requirements:

- **Art Contest:** We accept photographs of artwork in various styles (painting, graphic art, drawing, collage).
- **Music Contest:** Video recordings of performances (instrumental compositions only).
- **Literary Contest:** texts of poems, fairy tales, short stories, or essays.

5.2. Stages of the Contest:

1. **Online Stage:** submission of applications and entries via the project website.
2. **Final Results:** evaluation of entries by the Contest Organizing Committee and selection of winners.

5.3. Participation in the Contests is **free of charge**.

5.4. Entries will not be returned after the conclusion of the Contests and become the property of the Organizers.

5.5. Participation in the Contests implies consent to the use of entries in the project's informational materials.

VI. EVALUATION CRITERIA AND RESULTS

6.1. The Organizing Committee evaluates entries based on the following criteria:

- Originality and depth of the creative concept.
- Relevance to the themes and objectives of the Contests. (*See Appendix 1, "Contest Themes"*)
- Artistic, musical, or literary quality of the performance.

6.2. The best entries may be published in albums, anthologies, and on the project's online resources.

Themes for drawings and paintings:

1. **My Hero** (warrior, rescuer, scientist, teacher, parent, service, kindness, wisdom).
2. **Heroic Deeds for the Motherland** (historical events, modern heroes, patriotism, remembrance, honor).
3. **Friendship conquers all** (friendship between people, animals, nations, peace, cooperation, trust).
4. **The beauty of Russian nature** (forests, rivers, mountains, fields).
5. **Unity of peoples** (different cultures, traditions, shared values).
6. **Love for loved ones** (family, friends, birds, animals, care, respect, warmth, devotion).
7. **Light versus darkness** (good triumphs over evil, symbols of light).
8. **My favorite city/village** (places that inspire).
9. **Fairy-tale defenders** (knights, heroes, magical helpers).
10. **Space and dreams** (stars, planets, flights into the future, fantasy, progress, discoveries).

Topics for poems, stories, and fairy tales:

1. **A story about a real-life hero** (real or fictional).
2. **How I Helped a Friend** (a story about mutual support).
3. **My Homeland—My Pride** (about a favorite part of Russia, its culture, traditions, and legends).
4. **A fairy tale about good and evil** (where good triumphs).
5. **A journey into space** (a fantasy about other worlds, planets, discoveries, adventures, dreams).
6. **How nature teaches wisdom** (a conversation with a tree, a river, an animal).
7. **The unity of peoples** (a fairy tale or story about friendship between different cultures).
8. **A heroic deed in the name of love** (a story about self-sacrifice).
9. **My favorite holiday** (traditions, family values).
10. **A letter to future generations** (what I want to pass on to my descendants: wisdom, values, experience, hope).

Themes for musical compositions:

1. **Classical works** (world classics, modern masterpieces).
2. **Ode to Heroes** (ballads of heroic deeds, compositions about courage and bravery).
3. **Instrumental melody about friendship** (upbeat or lyrical).
4. **Melody of Native Nature** (sounds of the forest, river, mountains).
5. **March of the Victors** (energetic music about the triumph of good).
6. **Lullaby for the Motherland** (a tender melody about love for the homeland).
7. **Sounds of the cosmos** (a melody about stars and dreams).
8. **Hymn of unity** (about the friendship of peoples, family, and teamwork).
9. **Dance of joy** (a cheerful melody about happiness and love).
10. **Meditative music** (calm sounds for the harmony of the soul).
