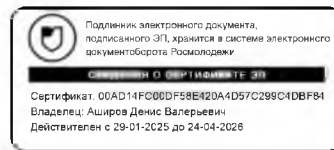

The grant competition is based on the principles of openness and transparency. Projects are evaluated by an expert council composed of representatives from educational institutions and relevant specialists. The experts select projects based on several criteria, including relevance, social impact, public significance, and the innovativeness of implementation methods and mechanisms, among others.

Applications for the grant competition are being accepted through the Ministry of Finance of the Russian Federation’s portal for state financial support measures until March 10, 2026. The selection results will be announced no later than April 1, 2026.
